<i>Harvest Connection for Children</i>	The <i>Harvest Connection</i> seminar in a format that mobilizes children to pray for and become involved with UPGs.	4 hours

<i>Final Focus</i>	A step by step seminar explaining how a church can research, choose and adopt a UPG in order to institute church planting movements among them.	6 hours	Mandarin Chinese, Indonesian, Spanish, Korean
<i>Healthy Churches in a Sick World</i>	Training that enables church leaders to assess the spiritual health of their church in relation to Jesus' mandate to disciple the nations. Contains diagnostic tools for measuring the health of your church along with steps to promote the church's spiritual health.	6 Hours	Arabic
<i>Missions Smarter</i>	This seminar trains churches to do missions SMARTer. It presents <b>S</b> trategy, <b>M</b> obilization, <b>A</b> dvancement, <b>R</b> esources and <b>T</b> raining in a way that helps churches organize themselves for successful mission's ministry.	6 hours	
<i>On the Cutting Edge</i>	A seminar that presents a step by step process that guides church leadership to create an effective missions policy for the local church.	4 hours	Mandarin Chinese
<i>Biblical Stewardship</i>	Teaching on how the good stewardship of our lives, relationships, time and resources can dramatically impact mobilizing the resources necessary for completing the Great Commission.	6-7 hours	Mandarin Chinese, Spanish
<i>Business as Mission</i>	Explores the biblical model for business and how business provides a platform for effective ministry. Students also learn how to financially and strategically analyze the business potential of opportunities in their midst. (From an AIMS partner, "Harvest Field Corners.")	6-8 hours	
<i>HIV AIDS Seminar</i>	A seminar that explores the basic nature, cause and prevention of this deadly disease. The seminar contains extensive small group work and is extremely practical in its focus and outcome. Taught by medical professionals.	8 hours

<i>Missionary Preparation In the Local Church</i>	Seminar designed to help pastors and elders effectively prepare missionary candidates in their churches for full-time, cross-cultural missions.	5-6 hours	Spanish
<i>Planning Strategies for World Evangelism</i>	Strategic insights that lead a church and missionaries in how to develop effective strategies for doing cross-cultural work with UPGs.	4-6 hours	Indonesian
<i>Strategic Power Shifts in Missions</i>	This seminar outlines 5 important power shifts that if instituted will launch local churches into completing the Great Commission. These power shifts are <b>A</b> ttitude, <b>A</b> ctions, <b>A</b> lignment, <b>A</b> bundance and <b>A</b> nointing.	5-6 hours	
<i>Security Seminar</i>	Emphasizes the basic issues faced by missionaries who are residing or visiting countries that are hostile to the free proclamation of the gospel. Included are instructions on how to avoid missteps in security sensitive regions of the world.	4 hours

<i>Understanding Islam, Loving Muslims</i>	Revolutionary ideas on how to share Jesus' love with Muslims.	5 hours	
<i>Biblical Basis for Partnerships</i>	A biblical study about the importance of partnering with God and each other. Envisions churches to work with others in order to complete the Great Commission.	2 hours	Armenian, Mandarin Chinese, French, Romanian, Russian, Spanish, Hindi, Indonesian, Portuguese
<i>Church Planting Movements</i>	A review of one of the most revolutionary model of missions in the world today. Discusses the 10 universal elements found in all CPMs.	1-2 hours	Indonesian, Russian, Spanish

<i>Equipping for the Harvest (Overview)</i>	AIMS training for leaders on how to form functioning partnerships that adopt and engage specific unreached people groups.	1 hour	Spanish, Mandarin Chinese
<i>Missions Foundations</i>	A teaching that gives a brief history of world missions and introduces the fundamentals of world evangelization. It is a wonderful introduction for churches new to missions. (Also comes in a 13 week course format.)	5-6 hours	Spanish
<i>Reliance on God versus Dependency on Foreign Resources</i>	An exploration of the contrast between mission practices that create dependency in those who receive the gospel, and those that promote a healthy reliance on God to provide all the resources necessary for ministry. It also covers how to avoid negative practices and how to help nationals get free from dependency on man.	3-4 Hours	Indonesian, Russian
<i>Strategic Sending</i>	Training on the strategies of both Jesus and Paul in sending out missionaries to disciple the nations. Finishes with a review on how to apply these strategies today. Companion to "Planning Strategies."	4-5 hours	Indonesian, Spanish
<i>World Religions Introduction</i>	An overview to introduce basic understanding of Buddhism, Hinduism, Animist, and Islam.	3 hours	
<i>Why are We Here?</i>	A challenge to align our vision and methods with God's Purpose, vision, strategy and methodologies.	1-2 hours	Indonesian, Romanian
<i>Exponential Church Planting</i>	Church planting beyond church planting movements: methodologies for rapid, even exponential church planting.	5-6 hours	
<i>A Vision for Closure</i>	How to record results for the evaluation of strategies to refine and improve them for closure-orientated objectives.	3-4 hours	Romanian
